TIME COMMITMENT

This volunteer role requires a minimum of 2 days a week, working from home initially with the option to meet at and work from the One Girl Office at the Abbotsford Convent on an as needed basis. You will need to show a Covid-19 vaccination certificate to be allowed into the Convent.

We can work with you to find a day and time that suits. Ideally, you'll begin ASAP and be able to commit for three months – although there may be an opportunity to stay on longer to join the restructured One Girl Communications team.

Please note, this is a volunteer position and all One Girl volunteers must complete a police check and (volunteer) working with children's check.
